

Requirements for the admission to Master degree course Wind Engineering at the Flensburg University of Applied Sciences

Master Wind Engineering

General admission requirements:

According to §32 of the examination and studies regulations of the above-mentioned Master's degree course:

(1) Admission to the Master's degree course may be granted to applicants who passed the final examination in the Bachelor's or Diploma degree courses **Mechanical Engineering or Electrical Energy Systems Engineering** at the FH Flensburg with a **minimum grade of GOOD** or who can present **at least two positive reports** written by professors concerning the passing of the final examination.

(2) In addition, applicants have to confirm that they have **at least satisfactory skills in the English language**. The confirmation can be given as follows:

- English as a mother tongue
- Completed degree course in the English language or
- Cambridge First Certificate or
- TOEFL test with an iBT Total Score of at least 80
- IELTS examination with an Overall Band Score of at least 6

(3) Applicants of related study courses may be granted admission to the Master's degree course provided they participate in individual courses. Based on suggestions of the person responsible for the study programme, the department will define the scope of the necessary courses and examinations. Depending on the scope, the requirements may be fulfilled in the first main semester or in an advanced semester (§20 sect. 4). The confirmation about the successful participation in these supplementary courses is the requirement for the admission to the examinations in the second semester.

Status of Student:

§29 sect. 3: Students will be registered as **full time students** at the university in which they complete their first main semester of the respective study course. Students, whose first degree course had a scope of 210 credits, will be registered as full time students at the Flensburg University of Applied Sciences in their first main semester and will continue their second main semester as **guest students** at the Kiel University of Applied Sciences.

Advanced Semester:

§29 sect. 4: Students, whose first degree course had a scope of less than 210 credits, will be registered at the Flensburg University of Applied Sciences in a so-called **advanced semester**. The **advanced semester** includes courses/lectures with a scope of the difference between the amount of credit points of the completed Bachelor's degree and 210 credit points. Based on suggestions of the person responsible for the study programme, the department will define the scope of the necessary courses and examinations. The confirmation about the successful participation in these supplementary courses is the requirement for the admission to the examinations in the second semester.
